<u>Decision</u>: SC-9/22: Synergies in preventing and combating illegal traffic and trade in hazardous chemicals and wastes

Background:

In decision SC-9/22, the Conference of the Parties, among other things, encouraged Parties that have not yet done so to establish national-level coordination mechanisms with a view to facilitating the exchange of information among relevant authorities responsible for the implementation and enforcement of the provisions of the Basel, the Rotterdam Convention and the Stockholm Convention aimed at controlling the export and import of the chemicals and wastes covered under the conventions, and encouraged Parties to provide information to the Secretariat about cases of illegal traffic and trade in the chemicals and wastes covered by the Basel, Rotterdam and Stockholm conventions, where the provision of such information is appropriate under existing reporting procedures.
