Invitation to submit comments to the POPs Review Committee on the "Draft general guidance on considerations related to alternatives and substitutes for POPs" and on the "Draft annotated outline for a guidance document on alternatives to perfluorooctane sulfonates (PFOS)"

The fourth meeting of the Persistent Organic Pollutants Review Committee took place on 13-17 October 2008 in Geneva. The report of the meeting is available at the Convention website: http://www.pops.int/poprc/.

The Committee established an intersessional working group on substitution and alternatives to POPs with the mandate to develop a text that describes the issues relating to alternatives and indicate the considerations related to persistence, bioaccumulation, long-range transport and toxicity that should be taken into account when dealing with possible alternative chemicals. In accordance with its mandate, the intersessional working group has prepared a draft general guidance text on alternatives to POPs, which is attached to the present letter.

Furthermore, the intersessional working group was also mandated to consider the modalities for producing a document on perfluorooctane sulfonate alternatives. Therefore, the group has drafted an outline for a possible guidance document. The development of the full guidance document is subject to approval by the POPs Review Committee at its fifth Meeting, scheduled to take place from 12 to 16 October 2009. A draft of this outline is also attached to the present letter.
