

9. Committee Administering the Mechanism for Promoting Implementation and Compliance

Decision: BC-13/9: Committee Administering the Mechanism for Promoting Implementation and Compliance

Background:

In decision BC-13/9, the Conference of the Parties, among other things, adopted the guidance on the implementation of the Basel Convention provisions dealing with illegal traffic (paragraphs 2, 3 and 4 of Article 9)¹ and encouraged Parties to use it and to provide information to the Secretariat on their experiences with the guidance for the consideration of the Committee. The Conference of the Parties also invited Parties, in particular Parties not having submitted their implementing legislation to the Secretariat, to undertake a review of their legislation for implementing the Convention, using the legislator's checklist, and to submit the outcome of their review to the Committee for its consideration. The Conference of the Parties further approved the work programme of the Committee for the biennium 2018–2019 and invited Parties to submit comments on three draft guidance documents under development: the revised version of the Committee's guidance on improving national reporting², the guide for the development of national legal frameworks to implement the Basel Convention³ and the guidance to improve the implementation of paragraph 11 of Article 6 of the Convention.⁴
