

14. Synergies in preventing and combating illegal traffic and trade in hazardous chemicals and wastes

Decisions: BC-15/27, RC-10/13 and SC-10/23: Synergies in preventing and combating illegal traffic and trade in hazardous chemicals and wastes

Background:

In part II of the abovementioned decisions, the Conference of the Parties to the Basel Convention reminded Parties to the Convention to report cases of illegal traffic using the prescribed form for confirmed cases of illegal traffic¹ or through table 9 of the format for national reporting.

In part III of those decisions, the conferences of the Parties to the Basel, Rotterdam and Stockholm conventions invited Parties to the three conventions to provide best practices for preventing and combating illegal traffic and trade in hazardous chemicals and wastes covered by the conventions, including the texts of any measures that have been adopted by them for that purpose.
