

#### **4. Technical guidelines on transboundary movements of electrical and electronic waste and used electrical and electronic equipment, in particular regarding the distinction between waste and non waste under the Basel Convention**

**Decision:** BC-15/7: Technical guidelines on transboundary movements of electrical and electronic waste and used electrical and electronic equipment, in particular regarding the distinction between waste and non waste under the Basel Convention

##### **Background:**

In decision BC-15/7, the Conference of the Parties decided to extend the mandate of the expert working group established by paragraph 5 of decision BC-13/5. It requested it to prepare updated technical guidelines, taking into consideration the comments received on the results of the use and/or testing of the technical guidelines, the amendments to Annexes II, VIII and IX to the Basel Convention adopted in decision BC-15/18 and paragraph 4 of decision BC-14/5, and to submit them for the consideration of the Conference of the Parties at its sixteenth meeting.
