## 6. <u>Technical guidelines on the environmentally sound management of waste lead-acid batteries and on</u> other waste batteries

<u>Decision</u>: BC-15/11: Technical guidelines on the environmentally sound management of waste lead-acid batteries and on other waste batteries

## Background:

The Conference of the Parties decided that the technical guidelines on the environmentally sound management of waste lead-acid batteries should be updated. It also decided that technical guidelines on the environmentally sound management of waste batteries other than waste lead-acid batteries should be developed.

The Conference further decided to establish a small intersessional working group to undertake, as a priority and a matter of urgency, the updating of the technical guidelines on the environmentally sound management of waste lead-acid batteries, as well as to develop the technical guidelines on the environmentally sound management of waste batteries other than waste lead-acid batteries.

The Conference of the Parties welcomed with appreciation the offer of Uruguay to act as a lead country in the updating of the technical guidelines on the environmentally sound management of waste lead-acid batteries and invited Parties to consider serving as co-lead country of their willingness to do so.
