

## 8. Electronic approaches to the notification and movement documents

Decision: BC-15/14: Electronic approaches to the notification and movement documents

Background:

The Conference of the Parties decided to establish a small intersessional working group to look further into electronic approaches to the notification and movement documents, taking into account the report of the first consultative workshop on electronic approaches to the notification and movement documents of the Basel Convention.<sup>1</sup>

(c)	Parties are invited to work on pilot projects on electronic approaches to the notification and movement documents and to submit their lessons learned to the Secretariat.	Parties	No deadline specified; information to be submitted as soon as possible
