- RESULTS
 - ABOUT 32 TONNES OF DDT WASTES WAS EXPORTED TO GERMANY WITH 300 TONS OF OBSOLETE PESTICIDES
 - 1 TON OF CONTAMINATED SOILS WITH DDT ARE STORED IN MAPUTO WAITING FOR A LOCAL DISPOSAL AND/OR TREATMENT.
 - MINISTRY OF HEALTH WILL GOING TO CONTINUOUS ACCUMULATING MORE DDT WASTE ON MALARIA PROGRAMME DURING 2008/2009

RECOMENDATION ON DDT WASTE

- TO AVOID PROBLEMS ASSOCIATED DDT AND MANAGEMENT OF WASTE WE RECOMMEND MINISTRY OF HEALTH TO:
 - WORKING CLOSELY WITH MINISTRY OF ENVIRONMENT AND AGRICULTURE
 - MINISTRY OF HAVE TO IMPLEMENT GOOD STRATEGY FOR DISPOSAL OF DDT WASTES AND OBSOLETE DDT
 - BOTH STAFF FROM MINISTRY OF HEALTH, ENVIRONMENT AND AGRICULTURE WITH ASSISTANCE OF FAO HAVE TO TAKE MONITORING ACTIVITIES IN ALL PLACES COVERED BY MALARIA PROGRAMME
