Decision: SC-12/2: DDT

Background:

The Conference of the Parties decided to evaluate, at its thirteenth meeting, the continued need for DDT for disease vector control on the basis of the available scientific, technical, environmental and economic information, including that provided by the DDT expert group. The Conference of the Parties also decided to continue, through the DDT expert group, the intersessional process of consultations with Parties in the DDT register on a possible phase-out plan for DDT and withdrawal from the DDT register, and requested the expert group to report to the Conference of the Parties at its thirteenth meeting on the prospects for phasing out DDT for those Parties.
