

Disease & Vector(s) targeted.	To be control the malaria vector in case of emergency.
Remarks	<p>DDT was used in a closed-system indoor site in a small amount to control disease vector, but it was forbidden strictly using outdoor in order to prevent pollution.</p> <p>DDT was mainly used in some malaria epidemic areas such as Yunnan province.</p> <p>The average annual consumption of DDT original power was about 300 tons.</p> <p>Presently, it is only kept to be used in case of emergency of malaria.</p>
